
IN MARYLAND, THE DISPARITIES FACED BY THE COMMUNITIES WE SERVE IN OUR BALTIMORE COUNTY CENTER ARE AMONG THE

WORST. The Baltimore County Department of Health determined those in the zip codes served by our current Randallstown Center vary between moderate and high on the Community Need Index because of:

- limited financial means,
- less access to care,
- lower life expectancies, and
- need for mental and substance use health care.

For those in our Baltimore County Center's communities, access is an even greater necessity.






OUR *MUSSION* TO MEET OUR COMMUNITY'S NEEDS IS CALLING.

Since 1999, when Dr. Michael Levine affiliated his Pikesville private primary care practice with Chase Brexton Health Care, Chase Brexton has continued to grow to improve health equity in the Randallstown and Woodlawn areas of west Baltimore County. In 2006, the Center officially shifted from being a private practice to being recognized Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) in Baltimore County. Today, Chase Brexton Health Care's Randallstown Center serves nearly 8,000 individuals of all ages.

With the right space, we will be able to expand and add:

- pediatric andprimary care exam spaces,
- an OB/GYN department
- add substance use treatment,
- expand our mental health services
- quicker appointments to help alleviate the increase in use of the emergency department
- a more robust pharmacy service
- additionalsocial workers to connect patients to needed resources and services
- diabetes management, hypertension monitoring, and other specialty programming offered at our larger center in Baltimore City.

Chase Brexton has the unique qualifications as a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) to work with individuals with financial and other barriers to care in order to address the community's most critical healthcare needs: access care, behavioral health services, substance use treatment, and chronic disease management.



FISCAL GROWTH

The additional clinic visits and new prescriptions are projected to generate an additional annual net income of approximately \$1.25 million per year. During the time of the 15-year lease, we anticipate an annual net income of approximately \$17 million. As a non-profit, this income will continue to be paid forward, enabling us to continue to grow our services and job opportunities for our communities.

Tonya* found herself in the emergency department after nearly six months of unexplained weight loss and suffering from extreme fatigue.

Working two minimum-wage jobs to make ends' meet and a mom of an energetic toddler, she chalked up her health issues to the side-effects her life.

At least, she hoped they were. She didn't have insurance, she didn't have any money to spare, and she couldn't afford to take time off from either of her jobs to see a doctor even if she did.
