

## ABOUT CHASE BREXTON'S EVERY MEAL MATTERS PROGRAM

### Chase Brexton's Every Meal Matters program helps ensure our patients won't go hungry.

Chase Brexton's Every Meal Matters program provides food security to patients in the communities we serve, offering them nutritious, healthy options from food pantries located at our Mt. Vernon, Columbia, and Security Square Centers. Every Meal Matters also offers patients nutritional information, including recipes curated by Chase Brexton's nutrition staff. The Every Meal Matters program is executed in partnership with the Maryland Food Bank, as well as volunteers from local businesses partnering with Chase Brexton.



## How It Started / Where It's Going

- 2022** – Chase Brexton's Every Meal Matters Program started in 2022 thanks to our Annual Baltimore Gala, when we began by distributing food in lobbies.
- 2023** – Our Mt. Vernon Center pantry opened, and special dietary foods were integrated into our diabetes management program.
- 2024** – Our Columbia Center and Security Square Center pantries opened. And, in what was a major boost for the program, the Every Meal Matters program purchased a van to aid in distribution.
- 2025** – Our Mt. Vernon Center pantry received a commercial refrigerator, allowing us to store food before it is distributed. We also hired a driver, and mapped out a plan.

We intend to work with local farms and the Maryland Food Bank's Retail Recovery program to grow our fresh produce program for patients – helping to feed people healthy food while we also eliminate food waste in our communities.

- 2026** – Our Glen Burnie Center's pantry will open. Look ahead, we plan to grow the Food As Medicine (FAM) program working with internal teams and local organizations such as Hungry Harvest to provide pre-made meals to diabetic patients. Your support will help our program flourish, as we hope to install commercial refrigeration in each center's pantry. You will also be helping to maintain our distribution vehicles and driver(s) salaries.



## How Will Funding Raised at the Gala Be Used?

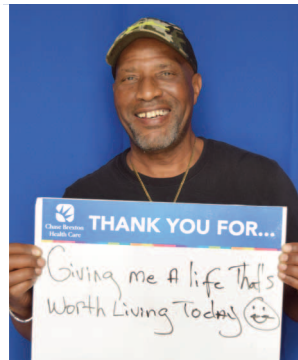
Funds raised will support the growth of our Every Meal Matters program in five ways:

1. **COLLABORATION.** To work with local farms and the Maryland Food Bank's Retail Recovery program to grow our fresh produce program for patients – helping to feed people healthy food while eliminating food waste in our communities.
2. **PARTNERSHIP.** To grow the Food As Medicine (FAM) program, working with internal teams and local organizations such as Hungry Harvest to provide pre-made meals to diabetic patients.
3. **DELIVERY.** To transport and deliver the food, by maintaining our Every Meal Matters' van and driver salary.
4. **EQUIPMENT.** To enhance our program by offering fresh produce to our patients, each pantry will benefit from commercial refrigeration.
5. **GROWTH.** To expand our program, by adding a pantry at our Glen Burnie Center.

## Impact and Notables



In 2025 our three pantries provided **120,330 lbs of food to 8,341 patients.**

We are on track to purchase over **150,000 lbs of food in 2026.**

**60% of our purchasing power** is dependant on grant funding.

We work closely with our Diabetes Management team that includes our nutritionists and provide a variety of **healthy recipes and nutrition information.**

To pilot the fresh produce program, we have added a refrigerator to our Mt. Vernon Center pantry and are **partnering with Fresh Farms** to receive fresh produce monthly.

## Why is the Every Meal Matters Program Significant?

According to the Maryland Food Bank, food insecurity is pervasive:

- In 2025, one-third of Marylanders (approximately two million people) are currently facing hunger.
- Older adults who are food insecure are 60% more likely to have congestive heart failure.
- Black communities experience hunger 2 times more compared to White communities.
- Two of three adults attributed their experience of food insecurity to inflation and rising food costs.
- Additional root causes are rent/home ownership costs, unemployment, low-wage jobs.

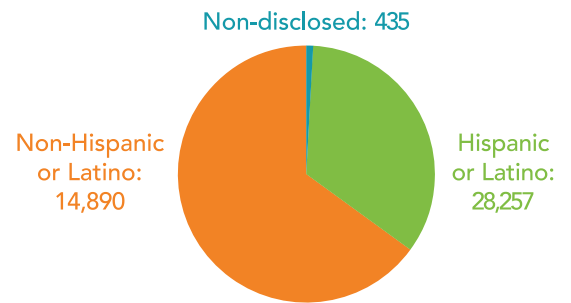
