40 Years Worth of Gratitude

To commemorate four decades of providing compassionate, quality health care—and the four decades of donations that have made it possible—Chase Brexton Health Care traveled to our locations throughout central Maryland to hear from patients about how Chase Brexton and our donors have improved their health and their lives.

“I can sleep now,” said Nisha Bhardway, who came to Chase Brexton’s center in Glen Burnie to get medical help for her uninsured parents. Her father, in his 80s, was finally able to receive hearing aids for only \$500, a necessity that would have cost \$4,000 elsewhere. “My parents have a doctor and access to prescription medicine. Most importantly, my father can hear now.”

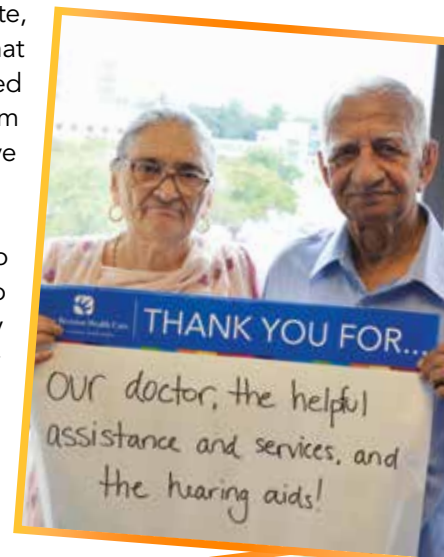

- David Shippee received our Leadership Award for guiding Chase Brexton from a volunteer-run organization to an incorporated non-profit during his 20-year tenure as CEO.

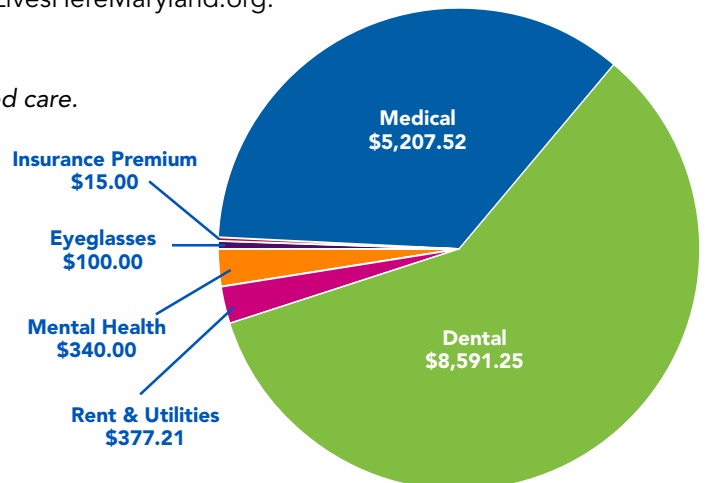
